



ServLine Leak Adjustment Program

- Starting August 1st, single unit residential customers will use ServLine for leak adjustments.
- \$1.70 monthly fee first appeared on July billings -ServLine is billed in advance.
- Customers who do not wish to participate must call ServLine (888-752-0339) to opt out.
- If you have a change of simply call ServLine at the same number to opt back in. The opt out period has ended. Opting back in requires a 30-day waiting period before filing a claim.

Beginning August 1, 2025

Leak Loss Protection Program*

The City of Frostburg offers protection against costly service bills caused by unexpected leaks. The City of Frostburg offers up to \$1,000 coverage per occurrence.

Combined Water & Sewer Leak

Residential

\$1.70 per month

In the event of a costly water or sewer bill caused by high water usage due to a qualifying leak or line break, the City of Frostburg's leak loss protection program covers a portion of the costly utility bill once the active cause of the leak has been repaired.

All eligible City of Frostburg residential customers are <u>automatically enrolled</u> in our optional expanded Water/Sewer Leak Loss Protection Program and charges will appear on your utility bill. Property owners must call ServLine to opt out of the program.

Call ServLine at 888-752-0339 to decline protection and accept full responsibility for all excess water/sewer charges caused by a leak.

The ServLine Protection Program is the only way qualifying leak adjustments will be made for leaks occurring after August 1, 2025 for single-unit residential customers.

- ★ Qualifying leaks must be greater than or equal to 2X the average monthly billed amount (⑤ not gallons).
- ★ Customers who apply for a leak adjustment under the program will need to pay an amount equal to their average monthly bill while the claim is being processed.
- ★ ServLine will reach out to the City for any historical or other data they may need as part of the claims process. The customer does not need to provide this information.

Reduce Paper and Simplify Payments

- Sign up to receive tax and utility bills by email. Receive a billing notice by email on the same day bills are generated. Avoid postal delivery delays!
- Enroll in ACH payments so the balance due is subtracted automatically from a bank account on the bill due date. Avoid late payments!
- View your bill or payment history online anytime through the City's website (frostburgcity.org) using your account number and PIN. Online payments can be made using a bank account (echeck) or a debit or credit card. Additional fees apply for online card payments.

Online Payments

The City now offers convenient online payment options for taxes, utilities, and permit fees. Through the online payment portal, utility and tax accounts may also be viewed for current balances and payment

Important!

- . Tax & Utility Payments: Once a payment is submitted an automated confirmation email will be sent from donotreply@link2gov.com (check spam/junk folder), If you do not receive a confirmation email then your payment likely did not go through. If confirmation was not received please call City Hall at 301-689-6000, ext. 106 to check if a payment processed.
- For Tax Payments: Customers need their District-Account Number (example: 99-99999) and Tax Account PIN. Customer Pin numbers are printed on the Tax Bill next to the Customer Account Number.
- · For Utility Payments: Customers need their Account ID number and the Account PIN. Account PIN numbers are printed on the Utility bills next to the Customer Account Number.
- . For Permit Fee Payments: You will need your permit number. If you don't know your permit number, please call the City Planner at 301-689-6000, ext. 110.






CSO Elimination Phases X-A, X-B & X-C
