- The Holiday Tree Lighting Committee added activities to the annual event.
- Pantry Partners provided finance/grant assistance for the Food Pantry.
- Our community supported a fund raising campaign for a new Food Pantry.
- Mt. Ridge Football Parents Fund purchased equipment and supplies.
- Frostburg Dog Park held their Annual Dog Splash Weekend in September.


